wen Evenstad has been selected to receive the 12018 Stroud Jordan award from the American Association of Candy Technologists. The award will be presented at a banquet on Tuesday, October 2, in Oak Brook, Illinois, during the National Technical Seminar.

Evenstad is the R&D and regulatory compliance manager at Sweet Candy Company, where she started as QA manager in 2001. Her responsibilities include research and development, product development, process optimization and food labeling.

Prior to joining Sweet Candy Company, Evenstad worked in various technical positions at Horizon Snack Foods, Sunsweet Growers and Gourmet Valley Foods. She has consulted for companies to improve accuracy and identify attributes to highlight on product packaging.

Evenstad has demonstrated her commitment to promoting both the industry overall, and education within the industry. In 2005, Evenstad founded the AACT Rocky Mountain chapter, which has become a large and successful organization. Each year, AACT Rocky Mountain partners with the local IFT chapter

to promote confectionery and food technology at the Utah Food Expo. She has served on the National AACT Council as Long Range Planning Committee chair and as part of the Program Committee. In those roles she has facilitated programming efforts with
